1. Apply to the Department of Veterans Affairs for education benefits.
2. If approved, the VA will send you a Certificate of Eligibility (CoE). Please send a copy of this certificate to the Office of Military-Affiliated Services at military@uncg.edu.
3. Register for classes.
4. Once you have registered for classes, complete and submit the online [Request for Class Certification \(RCC\)](#) (you must be logged into your UNCG email / iSPARTAN account to access).

Building Your Future With the GI Bill – VA Provided Information

Your First Semester Using GI Bill® Benefits at UNCG:

1. Apply to the Department of Veterans Affairs for education benefits at va.gov.
2. If approved, the VA will send you a Certificate of Eligibility (COE). Please send a copy of this certificate to the Office of Military-Affiliated Services at military@uncg.edu.
3. Register for classes with your advisor at a ([SOAR](#)) orientation session, or with a departmental advisor.
4. Once you have registered for classes, complete and submit the online [Request for Class Certification Form \(formerly VSE\)](#) (you must be logged into your UNCG email / iSPARTAN account to submit form).

Every Subsequent Semester Using GI Bill® Benefits at UNCG:

After your first semester, you MUST continue to complete the [Request for Class Certification Form \(formerly VSE\)](#) EVERY SEMESTER you wish to use your benefits. As soon as you register for classes, please complete the Request for Class
