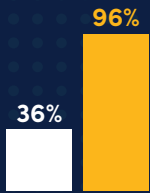


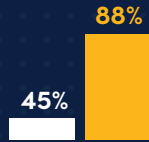

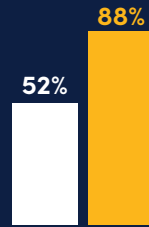
↑ 60%

increase in students who can identify at least three (3) campus support services and/or resources



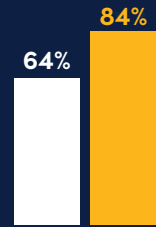
↑ 43%
