7 semester hours of Honors coursework with grades of B (3.0) or higher



Experiences

Foreign Language

Study of a language other than the student's native language (min. 102-level)



Timeline to Complete

All requirements must be completed by graduation and while attending UNC Greensboro

- HSS 198: Honors Colloquium I (1 s.h.)
- Two (2) Honors courses (3 s.h. each)

What is Honors Colloquium?

HSS 198: Honors Colloquium I

Taken in the student's first academic semester after being admitted to Lloyd International Honors College

7-week course



What is an Honors Course?

- Honors Seminar (HSS courses)
- Honors Section
- Honors Embedded Section
- Honors Contract



Foreign Language

Study of a language other than the student's native language at a level associated with 102-level language courses taught at UNCG



Completing a Language

- Coursework, placement tests, and appropriate evidence of mastery through other documentation
- Ancient languages and American Sign Language are currently permitted
- Languages other than those offered at UNCG are permitted
- Course work completed abroad or at other colleges is permitted
