

- Login to UNCGenie using ID and PIN
- Click on Student tab
- Click on Student Services and Financial Aid
- Click on Financial Aid Title IV Authorization

## **Section A: Authorization of Payment for Current Year**

- To authorize federal funds to pay for charges other than tuition, fees, room, and meal plan charges, such as parking permits, books, health insurance premium, and miscellaneous fines

## **Section B: Authorization of Payment for Prior Year**

- To authorize federal funds to pay prior term charges up to \$200
